



COVID-19 POLICY for Art Trails 2021

Sonoma County Art Trails Statement to Artists

- Sonoma County Art Trails' success depends on a collective presentation of artwork in all studios presented in the Art Trails Collector's Guide. All artists will be expected to open their studios and show their artwork to interested visitors.
- Sonoma County Art Trails and SebArts will comply with all County and State mandates for opening to the public. If there is a County or State mandate for a general shutdown, all artists will be informed immediately but otherwise we will continue to operate with current indoor masking and social distancing requirements.
- An artist having difficulty in the opening their studio for either health or personal reasons will present a request to representatives of the ATSC and SebArts for consideration and review. The appropriate representatives will work with the artist for a mutually beneficial solution. Studios with limited opening will be listed on sonomacountyarttrails.org and online interactive maps, and the artist is expected to inform their own contacts.
- The expectation for an artist receiving an exemption will be that the artist:
 - Have one piece of artwork in the Art Trails preview exhibition;
 - Show Artwork in front of their studio (this could be original artwork or reproductions);
 - Have a statement of apology for any inconvenience with reason for closure post at their studio;
 - Have information directing visitors to the online and physical Art Trails preview exhibit at SebArts;
 - List a phone number for making future studio visits appointments; and
 - (Strongly recommended) have a take-away such as a business card or postcard available at their studio.
